Kennedy has been an active member of Big Bethel A.M.E. Church since childhood and is happy to call Big Bethel her church home.

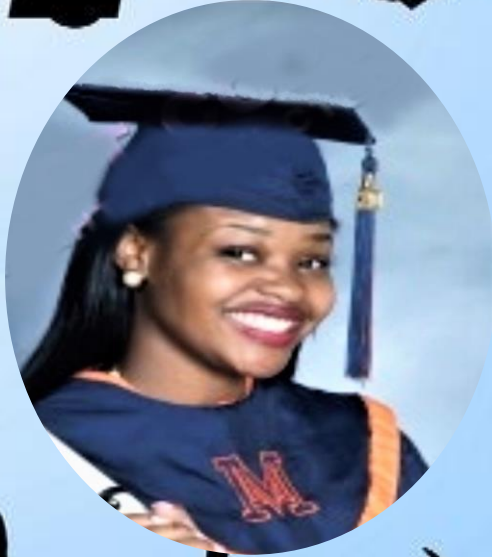
